No. 119—XII-32/2016-DE.—In partial modification of Board's Notification No.1930—XII- 60/89-DE., dated the 20th June 1989 under Rules 17 & 18 of Odisha District Revenue Services (Method of Recruitment & Conditions of Services) Rules, 1983, Board of Revenue, Odisha with approval of Government do hereby propose to make amendments to the following Syllabus and Rules for Departmental Training and Examination, refresher training and confirmation in service of the Officers of the District Revenue Service Cadre :—

In the Rule (1.1), the following shall be substituted, namely :—

The figures & words "2 & 1/2 months (seventy- five days) at the end shall be substituted as "45 (forty-five) working days".

In the Rule 1.2, the following shall be substituted, namely :—

The figure "8 A.M." shall be substituted as "2 P.M."

In Rule 1.3, the following shall be substituted, namely :—

The syllabus for practical training and theoretical training shall be as at Appendix-I.

In the Rule 1.4 the following shall be added :—

There shall be one refresher training of one week duration in every five years in order to keep the Amins abreast of the latest Acts/Rules Circulars and Amendments, Judgments coming directly or indirectly under the purview of Revenue Administration issued from time to time keeping pace with the emerging trend.

A member of the services in the Cadre of Amins shall not be allowed to draw the next annual increment, if he/she being sponsored by the authority willfully not attended the refresher training.

In the Rule 2, the following shall be deleted, namely :—

The Syllabus for theoretical and practical examination will be as at Appendix-II

In the Rule 3.1, the following shall be substituted, namely :—

(A) Every Officer appointed as Amin shall be eligible for confirmation, if he/she,—

- (i) has completed 06 (six) years of contractual service uninterruptedly;
- (ii) has undergone the Departmental Training and passed the examination successfully; and
- (iii) availability of CCRs at the time of confirmation.

(B) An officer appointed as Amin shall draw the first annual increment in the Time Scale on completion of one year of regular service. In no case, he/she shall be allowed to draw the second annual increment in the Time Scale until he/she has passed Departmental Training and Examination. Delay in passing the Departmental Training and Examination completely shall not have the effect of postponing the increment cumulatively, but arrear incremental dues shall not be allowed.

In Rule-4, the following shall be substituted, namely :—

Each Revenue Inspector appointed either on promotion or on direct recruitment shall undergo training in Revenue Inspector Training Institute managed by Government for a period of 60 ( sixty) working days except those covered by sub- rule (1) of Rule-17 of ODRS ( Method of Recriutment & Conditions of Service) Rules,1983.

In the Rule 4.2 the following shall be substituted, namely :—

There shall be one refresher training of one week duration in every five years interval in order to keep them abreast of the latest Rules, Circulars and Amendments, Judgements coming directly or indirectly under the purview of Revenue Administration issued from time to time keeping pace with the emerging trend.

A member of the Service in the Cadre of Revenue Inspector shall not be allowed to draw the next annual increment, if he/she being sponsored by the authority willfully not attend the refresher training.

In the Rule 4.3 the following shall be substituted, namely :—

The Syllabus for imparting theoretical training and practical training shall be as shown in Appendix-III.

In the Rule-5.2, the following shall be substituted, namely :—

The examination on theory shall be three papers, namely : Paper-I, Paper-II and Paper-III and examination on “ practical” shall be one paper, namely : Paper-IV as per the Syllabus at Appendix-IV.

The Rule 5.4 be deleted

In Rule 5.6, the following shall be substituted, namely :—

- (A) Every Officer appointed as Revenue Inspector shall be eligible for confirmation if he/she,
- (i) has completed 06 ( Six) years of contractual service uninterruptedly;
  - (ii) has undergone the Departmental Training and passed the examination successfully; and
  - (iii) availability of CCRs at the time of confirmation.
- (B) An officer appointed as Revenue Inspector shall draw the first annual increment in the Time Scale on completion of one year of regular service. In no case, he/she shall be allowed to draw the second annual increment in the Time Scale until he/she has passed Departmental Training and Examination. Delay in passing the Departmental Training and Examination completely shall not have the effect of postponing the increment cumulatively, but arear incremental dues shall not be allowed.

In the Rule 8 the following shall be substituted ,namely :—

8.1 The words “Collection Mohorir” shall be substituted by “Assistant Revenue Inspector”. Each Assistant Revenue Inspector appointed either on promotion or on direct recruitment shall undergo training in Revenue Inspector Training Institute managed by Government for a period of 45 ( forty-five) working days as per syllabus appended.



8.2 (a)- The training programme will be of two parts, namely "Theory" and "Practical". The practical training will be imparted on each working day of the duration of training commencing from 8 A.M. to 12.00 NOON in the field and theoretical training will be imparted in the classes in the Training Institute from 2 P.M. to 5 P.M.

(b) there shall be one refresher training of one week duration in every five years interval to keep them abreast of the latest Rules, Circulars and Amendments, Judgements covering directly or indirectly under the purview of Revenue Administration issued from time to time keeping pace with emerging trend.

A member of the Service, in the Cadre of Assistant Revenue Inspector shall not be allowed to draw the next annual increment, if he/she being sponsored by the authority willfully not attend the refresher training.

8.3 The syllabus for both the practical and theoretical training shall be as at Appendix-V

8.4 After completion of training each Assistant Revenue Inspector will appear Departmental Examination to be conducted by the Board of Revenue. The Departmental Examination shall be conducted on both "Theory and Practical" as per Syllabus in Appendix- VI

8.5 The examination in theory shall be in three papers, namely : Paper-I, Paper-II and Paper- III and examination on practical shall be one paper, namely : Paper-IV as per the Syllabus at Appendix-VI.

8.6 (A) Every Officer appointed as Assistant Revenue Inspector shall be eligible for confirmation, if he/she,—

- (i) has completed 06 ( six) years of contractual service uninterruptedly;
- (ii) has undergone the Departmental Training and passed the examination successfully; and
- (iii) availability of CCRs at the time of confirmation.

(B) An officer appointed as Assistant Revenue Inspector, shall draw the first annual increment in the Time Scale on completion of one year of regular service. In no case he/ she shall be allowed to draw the second annual increment in the Time Scale until he/she has passed the Departmental Training and Examination. Delay in passing the Departmental Training and Examination completely shall not have the effect of postponing the increment cumulatively, but arrear increment dues shall not be allowed.

**RESOLUTION**

SUBJECT—Working Procedure for execution of works under different Construction Corporations in the State.

In continuation of this Department Resolution No. 9133, dated the 6th September 2012, and in Supersession of this Department Resolution No. 6120, dated the 20th May 2015, after careful consideration, Government have been pleased to make following modifications in the working procedure, in respect of the works to be executed through the Public Sector Undertakings (PSU) Construction Corporation in the State.

1. Mechanical works shall be awarded to Corporations to execute Departmentally on negotiation basis through offers to be submitted by the Corporation basing on assessment of market rates, scrutiny by Project Level Technical Committee, recommendation by Tender Committee and approval by Govt. with overhead charges @ 10%.

2. For execution of specialized nature of civil structures, i.e. Dams & appurtenant, barrages, spillways, tunnels, syphons, adueducts, canals etc., the requisitioning authorities of Department shall request the corporation for preparation of DPRs after completing detailed survey, investigations, design and drawings of civil works. After finalization and approval of DPRs, the requisitioning authorities shall request the Corporation for execution of the works. However, the Corporation shall bear the survey, investigation, design, drawing and estimate charges out of overhead paid to them @10%.

3. The Officers of the Corporations are to be assisted by the concerned Divisions during execution, measurement as well as adhering the quality and quantity of works. The Departmental officers along with the officers of the Corporation will be fully associated in each work and will be responsible for implementation of works as per the agreements, terms and conditions. But, it may be adopted on case to case basis on the request of the Corporation to the requisitioning authorities.

4. Execution of deviated/extra items shall be approved by requisitioning authorities, subject to Para. 9 of Works Department Resolution No. 9133, dated the 6th September 2012.

5. Overhead charges will be considered for payment along with work advance and submission of utilization certificates, as per payment schedule stipulated in Para. 11 of the Works Department Resolution No. 9133, dated the 6th September 2012 and adjusted from Works Advance given.

6. Agreements will be signed between requisitioning authorities and Corporation after award of works.

7. The requisitioning authorities will bear the cost overrun/cost escalation in delays due to reasons not attributable to the Corporation, such as natural calamities, legal litigations and hindrances at site read with Para. 12 of Works Department Resolution No. 9133, dated the 6th September 2012. However, the Corporation will ensure, while selecting the executing agencies that the works do not hamper for non-performance of the executing agencies.

8. The time schedules may be decided by the requisitioning authorities in consultation with the Corporations, while drawing the agreements.

9. The extension of time may be granted by the Corporation with approval of requisitioning authorities, subject to the provisions of OPWD Code.

10. The requisitioning authorities may issue credentials/work completion certificates to the Corporation and executing agencies jointly.

11. The Corporations will go for limited open tenders among enlisted job workers/contractors. However the list of Job-workers/contractors maintained by the corporations should be up dated every year through open advertisements in a transparent way.

12. The stipulations of Para. 3-11 is applicable to works mentioned in Para. 1 & 2.

This has been concurred by Finance Department vide their U.O.R. No, 01/WF-I, dated the 2nd January 2016.
