AGRICULTURE DEPARTMENT**NOTIFICATION**

No. 8307—AG-PG-II-48/2016—For a realistic assessment of the crop cutting results, feedback and policy formulation, it is necessary that data is obtained in a scientific manner and is credible. The present system of collecting data on crop yield of paddy, based on crop cutting experiments carried out by the Directorate of Economics and Statistics needs to be strengthened and augmented. The following steps will be taken for the year 2016-17 :—

- (1) The Directorate of Economics and Statistics under the Planning and Convergence Department is to be strengthened by taking people on Deputation/Consultants at a senior level to assist the Director. The staff at the field level should also be augmented.
- (2) The Statistics Cell in the Directorate of Agriculture and Food Production is to be augmented by posting officers of the Agriculture Department with knowledge of statistics and if necessary, one or two persons with economic & statistics background may be taken on deputation or as consultants.
- (3) The Directorate of Agriculture and Food Production will oversee the implementation of use of technology like handled tablets, mobiles at the time of crop cutting and reporting of data along with photographs. It will have an agreement with the Mahalanobis National Crop Forecasting Centre (MNCFC) and National Remote Sensing Agency (NRSA) for this purpose and also assist in procurement of infrastructure which should be completed by July, 2017.

50% of funds for this purpose can also be made under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) from Government of India, for which a proposal is to be sent separately by Department of Agriculture & Farmer's Empowerment.

- (4) Earlier the crop cutting experiments were supervised very closely by the District Administration which of late has fallen into desuetude. Instructions may be given by the Government for giving specific targets to Collectors/ Sub-Collectors, Tahasildars, DDAs and other district functionaries for personal supervision of crop cutting experiments.
- (5) Data is being provided to the Department based on satellites/remote sensing. This should be used for triangulation for actual crop assessment and crop cutting estimate on regular basis during Kharif /Rabi.

A Committee is constituted at the State Level and another at District Level as follows to monitor the same on fortnightly basis.

- (6) To audit the crop cutting experiment, it is necessary to have engagement of 3rd party for this purpose. There are at present three empanelled entities for this purpose by Government of India. One of these will be engaged by the Agriculture and Farmers Empowerment Department, Odisha for auditing of area and yield estimation of crops.
- (7) In the long run there is a necessity of improving estimation on a regular basis using satellite data / other parameters like sunlight, rainfall, temperature/humidity etc. Two such models are being developed at present for paddy, one by MNCFC and other developed by International Rice Research Institute (IRRI). The State Government will enhance its capacity to collect relevant data and use these models for forecasting and estimating paddy yield. A specific agreement will be signed with MNCFC and IRRI in the year 2016-17 for this purpose.
- (8) A Committee has been constituted under the Directorate of Agriculture & Food Production for setting up of automatic weather stations and ARGs in the State. Adequate budgetary support to set up the Stations will need to be providing during 2016-17.

To oversee the implementation of the entire programme in a time bound manner for Kharif 2016-17. A Committee is constituted under the Chairmanship of Development Commissioner-cum-ACS, as follows :—
