RULES FOR ADMISSION INTO THE GOVERNMENT COMMERCIAL CLASS ATTACHED TO THE RADHANATH ELEMENTARY TEACHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION, CUTTACK SESSION 2018-2019

The next Session of the Government Commercial Class attached to the Radhanath Elementary Teacher Education Institution, Cuttack begins from the 1st July 2018 and extends over a period of one year. Admission will ordinarily be closed on the 31st July 2018 provided the seats are not filled up till then. The maximum number of seats available is forty-eight. There is no hostel accommodation for the students of the Government Commercial Class.

2. Subjects taught are —

- (i) Shorthand;
- (ii) Typewriting and Drafting ; and
- (iii) Book Keeping.

3. The classes are generally held in the morning from 7 A.M. to 12 NOON.

4. The minimum qualification for admission is Matriculation or its equivalent. Preference will however be given to those who possess better and higher qualifications. No admission will be made without personal interview. An entrance test, if necessary, will be held on a specific date which will be intimated in due course. The candidates selected for admission must produce their original Matriculation or Secondary School Leaving Certificate and other Certificates of Higher Qualifications, if any, on the date of admission.

5. Candidates are required to produce their Certificates and Mark Sheets in original for verification at the time of interview.

6. Forty per cent of the seats are reserved for Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe students.

7. Twenty-five per cent of the seats are reserved for girl students.

8. If the required number of candidates of any of the reserved category are not available, the vacant seats shall be filled up by the candidates of general category on merit.

9. Career marks would be considered in selection of candidates.

10. Marks secured in the Board Examination are to be taken into consideration.

11. Cases of candidates applying for Typewriting only are to be considered later since there are other candidates seeking admission for both Shorthand and Typewriting or full course.

12. Fees are charged at the following rates:—

(i) Single Subjects . . . Rs. 3

(ii) Any two Subjects . . . Rs. 5

(iii) Full Course . . . Rs. 6

13. Ex-students of the class either plucked or unable to appear at the final examination after completing the course will be allowed to appear twice as private candidates on payment of the examination fee.

14. Application for admission should be sent by the **20th May 2018** in the Form appended herewith which can be had by the candidates from the office of the Government Commercial Class attached to the Radhanath Elementary Teacher Education Institution, Cuttack during office hours from **7 A.M. to 12 Noon** either in person or by sending a self-addressed envelope with postage stamp worth Rs. 10. No application should send by name but must be addressed to the **Teacher-in-charge, Government Commercial Class attached to Radhanath Elementary Teacher Education Institution, Cuttack-2.**

15. Candidates are required to attach self-attested self copies of **Matriculation Mark Sheet, Certificate and other higher qualifications**, if any, with Application Form.
