The Odisha Panchayat Samiti T.A. Rules, 1975 regulates the payment of allowance to the Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson and Members of the Samiti. Similarly, Rule 11 of Odisha Gram Panchayat Rules, 1968 prescribes the rate at which Sarpanch, Naib-Sarpanch and Ward Member shall get daily allowance and sitting fees. So also, Section 10 of Odisha Zilla Parishad Act, 1991 prescribes honorarium for President/Vice-President.

These rates were fixed long time back and deserve revision in the context of present price index and rising cost of living and mobility.
