Circle concerned for award and execution of contracts in which his or her spouse's near relative (defined as first blood relations, and their spouses) is posted as Divisional Accountant/ Divisional Accounts Officer or as an officer in any capacity between the grades of Superintending Engineer and Junior Engineer (Both inclusive).

8. No Engineer of Gazetted Rank or other Gazetted Officer employed in Engineering or Administrative duties in an Engineering Department in State Government is allowed to work as contractor for period of two years after his retirement from Government service without Government permission.

9. The name of the contractors, who are participating in this e-tender but not submitting the original cost of tender paper and bid security, will be reported to the State e-Procurement Cell as well as to the higher authorities for necessary action against them.
