SUBJECT—Reinitiation of Ophthalmic Assistant Training in the State.

No. 11050—ME-II-M-35/2018-H.—National Programme for Control of Blindness (NPCB) started in 1976 in India. For implementation of NPCB in the State of Odisha to meet the need of manpower, a training for Ophthalmic Assistant was started in 1980. No admission of the students for Ophthalmic Assistant Training was done since 1995. As computed, by the end of 2020, there will be 102 numbers of Paramedical Ophthalmic Assistant only in the State against the sanctioned post of 197.

Further, under the Vision 2020 Programme of NPCB India, there is a recommendation to have one Vision Centre for 50,000 population manned by the Ophthalmic Assistants. Therefore, there is a requirement of around 840 Ophthalmic Assistant in the entire State. In order to meet the human resource need for implementation of Universal Eye Health Programme in the State, Government, after careful consideration of the proposal, have been pleased to re-initiate Ophthalmic Assistant Training from the academic session 2018-19 in 03 Government Medical College & Hospitals and Capital Hospital, Bhubaneswar that was running earlier in the state with following stipulations :

1. Resource persons for 10 candidates in each batch in 03 Government Medical Colleges i.e. SCB Medical College & Hospital, Cuttack, MKCG Medical College & Hospital, Berhampur and VIMSAR, Burla and for 05 (five) trainees in Capital Hospital, Bhubaneswar shall be available to accommodate the trainees.
2. The period of course of the Ophthalmic Assistant Training shall be for 02 (two) years as was done earlier.

3. The modalities of selection of candidates for the training shall be +2 Science or equivalent qualification with at least 50% marks in qualifying examination as has been done in previous years. The selection shall be made on mark basis.

4. The Ophthalmic Assistant Examination Board which was constituted by Government, Health & F.W. Department vide their Notification No.2581-H, dated the 7th August 1982 shall be adopted for the ensuing Ophthalmic Assistant Training.
