S. R. O. No. 11/2018—Whereas, the State Government are satisfied that public interest requires declaration of the Odisha State Co-operative Milk Producer's Federation Ltd. (OMFED), Bhubaneswar and its Units operating in the different districts in the State of Odisha to be a Public Utility Services.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of sub-clause (vi) of Clause (n) of Section 2 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (14 of 1947), the State Government do hereby declare the said industry to be a Public Utility Service for the purpose of the said Act for a period of six months with effect from the date of issue of the Notification.
