RESOLUTION

The 22nd July 2017

**SUBJECT**—Award of incentive in shape of cash grant to encourage inter-cast marriage between the Caste Hindus and Scheduled Caste belonging to the Hindu Community.

**Reads**—Government Resolution No. 21332-HTW., dated the 26th June 1980, No. 17393-HTW., dated the 15th July 1981, No. 33541, dated the 17th September 2005 and No. 43620-SSD., dated the 3rd December 2007.

The proposal of enhancement of the rate of award of incentive in shape of cash grant to the couples of inter-caste marriages solemnized between the Scheduled Caste belonging to the Hindu Community and other caste—Hindus, was under consideration of Government for some time past. This proposal was discussed in the meeting of the Scheduled Caste Welfare Advisory Board held on the 5th June 2015 under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Odisha and it was resolved

that the rate of award of incentive in shape of cash grant should be increased from Rs. 50,000 to Rs. 1,00,000 to encourage inter-caste marriage for the purpose of eradication of untouchability and that there should not be any income restriction in the award of this incentive.

2. The State Government, after careful consideration have been pleased to decide that rate of award of incentive in shape of cash grant to the couples of inter-caste marriages which was fixed at Rs. 50,000 (Rupees fifty thousand) only in Para. 2 of the Resolution No. 43620-SSD., dated the 3rd December 2007 referred to above shall be enhanced to Rs. 1,00,000 (Rupees one lakh) only per inter-caste married couple irrespective of the income of the recipients.

3. Both the couple shall have to apply for sanction of the grant in the form set out in Annexure-I. The recipients of the grant shall be a person belonging to other caste-Hindus(either sex) marrying from Scheduled Caste community who shall have to execute a bond in the form set out in Annexure-II before receiving the grant. The model form of office order prescribed for sanction of the grant indicated at Annexure-III.

4. This shall take effect from the date of the issue of the Resolution.

5. All other provisions made in the original Resolution referred to above shall remain unchanged.

6. This resolution issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department, dated the 11th September 2016 in File No. SOS2-MISC-0007-2015 and Planning and Convergence Department, dated the 21st June 2017 in File No. PC-PLIII-REFF-0004-2017.

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ORDER—Ordered that the Resolution be published in the next issue the *Odisha Gazette* for the general information and copies communicated to all Departments of Government/all Heads of the Departments/all Collectors.
