#### 1. Short title and commencement :-

- (1) These rules may be called the Odisha Prison Services (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of Sub-Assistant Jailor) Amendment Rules, 2018.
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Odisha Gazette
- 2. In the said rules, for Clause (b) of sub-rule (1) of Rule 2, the following shall be substituted:
  - (b) "Committee" means Departmental Promotion Committee
- 3. In the said rules, for Rule 4, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:—
- **"4. Recruitment :** Subject to the provisions made in these rules, recruitment, to the post of Sub-Assistant Jailor, shall be made by way of promotion from among the Chief Warders in the Jails of the State :

Provided that in case of non-availability of suitable candidates from among the Chief Warders, Warders with at least 10(ten) years of continuous service may be considered for such promotion, subject to their merit with due regards to seniority".

- **5.** In the said rules, for sub-rule (1) of Rule 6, the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—
  - "(1) In order to be eligible for promotion, to the post of Sub-Assistant Jailor a Chief Warder, must have,—

Member

- (a) completed at least 10(ten) years of continuous service in post of Warder & Chief Warder taken together as on 1st January of the year in which the Departmental Promotion Committee conducts the selection;
- (b) passed Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination or equivalent examination from a recognized Board or Council; and
  - (c) successfully completed the basic training of Warder.

(1a) The warders whose case is considered under Rule 4, must have fulfilled the eligibility criteria provided in clause (b) and (c) of sub-rule (1):

Provided that the warders who were appointed prior to 2012 having HSC passed qualification and have completed 15 years of service, shall be eligible for promotion".

- (d) Establishment Officer (Field . . . Member-Convener'' Establishment).
- **7.** In the said rules, for Rule 8, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-
- "8. Procedure for selection by the Departmental Promotion Committee :-
- (1) The Prisons Directorate shall maintain a State-wise Gradation List of Chief Warders, who shall form the feeder cadre for promotion to the post of Sub-Assistant Jailor.
- (2) The Gradation List of all Circle Jails shall be revised merging at the Directorate level and the merged Gradation List shall be prepared on the basis of seniority in entry grade.
- (3) Promotion to the rank of Sub-Assistant Jailor shall be made by way of selection on the basis of merit-*cum*-suitability in all respect with due regard to seniority.
- (4) All relevant rules, instructions and circulars of the Government in the matter of promotion, as amended from time to time shall be followed.
- (5) The Committee, while considering the cases of suitable Chief Warders or Warders

and preparation of the select list shall adhere to the following provisions, namely:—

- (d) The Odisha Civil Services (Criteria for Selection for Appointment including Promotion) Rules, 2003.
- (6) The recommendation of the Committee shall be valid and can be acted upon, notwithstanding the absence of anyone of its members other than the Chairman:

Provided that the member so absenting was duly invited to attend the meeting of the Committee and the majority of the Committee attended the meeting.

- (7) The list prepared by the Committee, after being approved by the Government, shall form the select list for appointment to the post in the service.
- (8) The select list shall ordinarily remain in force for a period of one year from the date of its approval or until another select list is prepared, whichever is earlier.
- (9) Appointment to the posts in service shall be made in the order in which the names of the persons appear in the select list."
- 8. In the said Rules, Rule 9 and 10 shall be omitted.

It has been decided by the Government to undertake the operation of land survey and settlement work expeditiously through Hi-tech method all over the State to prepare land records. After successful execution of survey work in Nine (09) Districts on a pilot basis, it is being contemplated now to carry out the work in all Tahasils of the State. In order to carry out the above survey work adopting Hi-tech method smoothly, additional technical man power is required in the post of Revenue Supervisor, Revenue Inspector and Amin.

At present, existing employees with experience and expertise in this field are working in the Directorate of Land Record & Survey and Consolidation. With a view to utilize the service of the above employees in the survey work, Government have been pleased to deploy them against the vacant posts of Revenue Supervisor, Revenue Inspector and Amin under Revenue Organization for the Hitech survey work with following terms and conditions.

 The employees working as Head Draftsman, Assistant Draftsman, Sheristadar and Head Area Estimator under the Director of Land Records Survey and Consolidation shall be deployed in the Revenue Organization to work as Revenue Supervisor. Similarly, existing Inspector, Peskar and Draftsman shall be deployed to work as Revenue Inspector and existing Amins and Munsarims shall be deployed to work as Amins in the Revenue

Organization.

- 2. For deployment of the above employees of Settlement and Consolidation in the Revenue Organization, equal number of posts such as. Revenue Supervisor, Revenue inspector and Amin shall be created in the scale of pay attached to those posts. The above posts shall not be filled up in any manner except deployment from Settlement and Consolidation in future. Such creation of respective posts shall not be included in the posts of existing
- 3. These employees shall draw their corresponding pay in the scale attached to the post to which they are deployed after creation of said posts under Revenue Organization. In case the employee draws pay in higher scale than the scale attached to the post held under Revenue organization on account of availing RACP, he/she shall continue to draw pay in
- The above posts that are specifically created for the purpose of Hi-tech survey work shall continue under Revenue organization till retirement of the last employee in the bottom post of the cadre under Land Records & Survey and Consolidation Organization.
   The lien of the employees shall not be suspended in the post under their original cadre on such deployment. Accordingly, promotion shall be considered as per the gradation list.
- such deployment. Accordingly, promotion shall be considered as per the gradation list prepared on the basis of seniority in their original cadre. After getting promotion in the original cadre, the employee shall be posted automatically against the equivalent post created in the Revenue Organization.6. The pension of such employees on deployment after retirement on superannuation, death

in harness, removal from service or otherwise shall be determined basing on the last

presumptive pay to be arrived in the post had he/she continued under original cadre.

- 7. In case of any difficulty or doubt arises while implementing the above clauses, the matter shall be referred to Government in Revenue & Disaster Management Department.
- 8. The whole clauses or part of the said Resolution shall not be invoked in case of any other
- State Government employees except the aforesaid employees of the Land Records, Survey & Consolidation Organization as this is done specifically for the purpose mentioned above.
